

Court Processing of Civil Cases

If you have been sued, or are thinking about filing law suit, it may be a good idea to promptly contact the court clerk's office for the court in which the case has been, or may be, filed. Due to the Covid 19 pandemic the Chief Justice of the Oregon Supreme Court has issued standing orders that restrict court operations in order to protect the public and court employees. Different courts have been affected in varying degrees. In some courts civil cases may be completely stalled, meaning that no action is presently being taken on them, and no hearing or trial dates are available.
